



## A.I.R.E. enrolment for Italians Abroad

### What is A.I.R.E.

In each Italian Municipality there is an updated registry of their citizens residing abroad (called A.I.R.E.), as well as in every Consulate there is a registry of Italian citizens residing within its consular jurisdiction (Anagrafe Consolare). Pursuant to Act 470 of 27 October 1988, Italian citizens who transfer their residency abroad must inform the relevant consular office, with a specific declaration, **within ninety days from their immigration.**

### A.I.R.E. Registration procedure

If you intend to live in Australia for more than 12 months, You must register in A.I.R.E. you will need to login to the online portal [FAST-IT](#) and complete, print and sign the AIRE request and lodge the following documentation;

- The completed and signed form including each member of the family resident at the same address;
- In case of minor children, both parents must sign the request and include a copy of a current photo ID
- Copy of the following documents:
  - valid Italian passport for each Italian member of the family;
  - Evidence of a stable residential address in South Australia (i.e. copy of SA's driver's licence or utility bills, employment contract, residential tenancy lease, bank account statement);

In case the birth certificates of minor children have not yet been registered in Italy, please follow the procedure for the registration in Italy of the above, before requesting the AIRE enrolment. ### Important

By law, the consular registry does not have any official registration value; therefore **the consular offices CANNOT issue certificates of residence or of family status.**  
**The AIRE certificate of residence as well as the family status may be issued only by the Italian body that holds the registry functions, in the Municipality of AIRE registration.**

The Consulate will only be able to issue certificates of registration in the register, in which it will be possible to indicate that the person concerned is living at the address present in the register, as well as what appears to be the composition of the family unit.
